SUBMISSION DEADLINE: Sun. Apr. 28

SELECTION PROCESS: All work will be reviews by the Fells staff and exhibition director

NOTIFICATION: By May 12

ENTRY FEE: \$25 to NHAA

SUBMISSION DROP OFF: At The Fells on May 22 between 10 am and 12 pm, or at The Robert Lincoln Levy Gallery Wed. May 17th and Thurs. May 18th 11 am to 5 pm.

SUBMISSION PICK UP: At The Fells on July 10, 10 am to 12 pm or at the Robert Lincoln Levy Gallery, date TBD

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Email 1 to 6 images of artwork to: callforart@nhartassociation.org.
2. Subject of email: The Beauty of NH at the Fells, Attn. Jessica
3. Attach images as JPEG, JPG at 300dpi resolution with the largest dimension no larger than 6" jpeg format.
4. Label images as follows: Title_1.jpeg (Sunflowers_1.jpeg).
5. In the body of the email include the following information:
 - a. Artist Name
 - b. Contact phone number and email
 - c. Medium
 - d. Artwork Dimensions
 - e. Payment method
 - f. Payment must be made by application deadline

OPENING RECEPTION:

Friday, May 26, The Main House, The Fells, 405 Route 103A, Newbury NH, 5-7 PM

The Fells Opening Member Reception will also be the opening for the sculpture and Gallery art exhibits. 250+ guests normally attend this event. Artists should plan to attend the opening reception, to engage guest interested in their art.

LIABILITY:

Work will be handled with all possible care, but the NHAA will not be responsible for loss or damage from any cause. Submitting work will imply agreement on the part of the artist with this condition.

SALES:

All work must be for sale--no NFS will be accepted. The NHAA retains 40% commission on work sold, which will be split 20% for the NHAA and 20% for the Fells. The Fells will process payment from the buyer and cut the necessary checks--60% to the artist and 20%

REQUIREMENTS:

- Work must be properly labeled on the back with the artist's name, title of work, medium and price.
- All work must be for sale
- No artwork will be accepted that have been previously in a previous Fells show
- Art must be of professional quality and must comply with all NHAA framing policies (see below)
- NHAA exhibits only original works of art. Customers who purchase art from a professional art organization such as the NHAA should receive artwork that is professionally framed, finished and identified.

NHAA PRESENTATION and FRAMING POLICIES:**2D ARTWORK /WORKS ON PAPER**

- Policies apply to all NHAA exhibitions, including both on and offsite locations.
- It is the sole responsibility of the artist to abide by current trademark and copyright laws. Copyright infringement will result in the loss of NHAA membership.
- (Including drawings, photography, and all printmaking)
- Artist must indicate the edition size and number on any and all edition work. The NHAA exhibits only original works of art. If it is an open edition, please state that clearly.
- All works on paper must be framed and should be matted or lifted away from the glass with archival matting or spacers.
- Frames and mats must be clean, professionally cut/constructed, and undamaged.
- At delivery, all works must be wired and ready to hang.
- Sawtooth hangers will NOT be accepted.

WORKS ON CANVAS

- Works on canvas do not need to be framed as long as sides of canvas are painted or finished with a strip frame.
- Surface and corners should be taut, wrinkle-free, and free of visible threads or staples.
- At delivery, all works must be wired and ready to hang.
- All work must be completely dry.
- Works on artboard, masonite, wood, etc., must follow the above requirements and instructions.

- Sawtooth hangers will NOT be accepted.
