**ELIGIBILITY:** NHAA Members

**SUBMISSIONS ACCEPTED:** All mediums accepted, 1-2 framed (1 piece not to exceed 18"x24" or 2 smaller pieces), up to 5 unframed small works

**HANGING FEE:** \$10 per artwork, no charge for unframed small works

**SUBMISSION DROP-OFF:** Monday, April 2, 12PM-7PM

**SUBMISSION PICK-UP:** Monday, April 30, 12PM-7PM

**EXHIBITION THEME:** April is Adopt a Pet Month and the theme of this exhibit focuses on animals both wild and free. NHAA members are welcome to bring in their animal-themed artwork in any medium to exhibit in the Gerry Frazier Gallery. Throughout the month, NHAA will be partnering with Cocheco Valley Humane Society to raise awareness of the importance of adopting animals while featuring animal-themed-artwork. *There will also be a special reception, Saturday, April 7 along with animal related raffles throughout the month.*

**PARTNERSHIP WITH COCHECO VALLEY HUMANE SOCIETY (CVHS):** For the month, NHAA is partnering with this special organization and are collecting monetary donations or any CVHS wish list item (toys for cats/dogs, guinea pig food, peanut butter, cat litter, rabbit food, etc.) *For a complete list please access their website.* "A community-funded, nonprofit 501(c)3 organization, Cocheco Valley Humane Society (CVHS) is dedicated to promoting the humane treatment of animals in Strafford County, NH and Southern Maine. We are a safe, temporary home for more than 1,500 surrendered, lost, abused, neglected, or unwanted animals each year." – *CVHS mission statement*

**ARTIST PRESENCE IN THE GALLERY:** The Association is grateful for member support. NHAA members are strongly encouraged to spend time in the gallery during any month when their work is exhibited. Meeting with potential buyers has a positive and significant impact on the likelihood of selling your artwork. NHAA understands that some members may have restrictions that prevent them from being in the gallery during the month, so we encourage members to reach out to gallery staff to find another way to help.

## **NHAA PRESENTATION & FRAMING POLICIES**

Policies apply to all NHAA exhibitions, including both on and offsite locations. NHAA exhibits only original works of art. Customers who purchase art from a professional organization, such as NHAA, expect work that is professionally framed and finished, front and back. It is the sole responsibility of the artist to abide by current trademark and copyright laws. Copyright infringement will result in the loss of NHAA membership.

### **Framed**

**Works on Paper:** Drawings, photography, and all printmaking

- Artist must indicate edition size and number on any and all edition work. The NHAA exhibits only original works of art. If it is an open edition, please state that clearly
- All works on paper should be framed and matted or lifted away from the glass with archival matting or spacers
- Frames and mats must be clean, professionally cut/constructed, and undamaged.
- At delivery, all works must be wired and ready to hang. Saw tooth hangers NOT accepted.

**Works on Canvas:**

- Works on canvas do not need to be framed as long as sides of canvas are clean, painted, or finished with a strip frame
- Surface and corners should be taut, wrinkle-free, and free of visible threads or staples.
- At delivery, all works must be wired and ready to hang
- All work must be completely dry
- Works on artboard, masonite, wood, etc., must follow the above requirements

**Three-Dimensional Work (3D):**

- Any three-dimensional work intended for wall hanging must have appropriate hanging devices built into the piece. The piece should be wired if necessary and should also include any instructions for hanging
- In the case of art that is not hung, e.g. sculpture, consideration must be given to the underside to assure it is finished to protect it and the surface on which it rests
- All three-dimensional work must be structurally stable or otherwise contained

**Small Works - Unframed:**

- All pieces must be in clear plastic sleeves and labeled on the back with artist's name, title, medium and price
- Size limitations: 16in in the longest direction, including mat or backing board
- Price of artwork must not exceed \$300
- All work must be for sale
- Presentation must be clean and professionally presented. Artwork that does not meet these requirements will not be displayed
